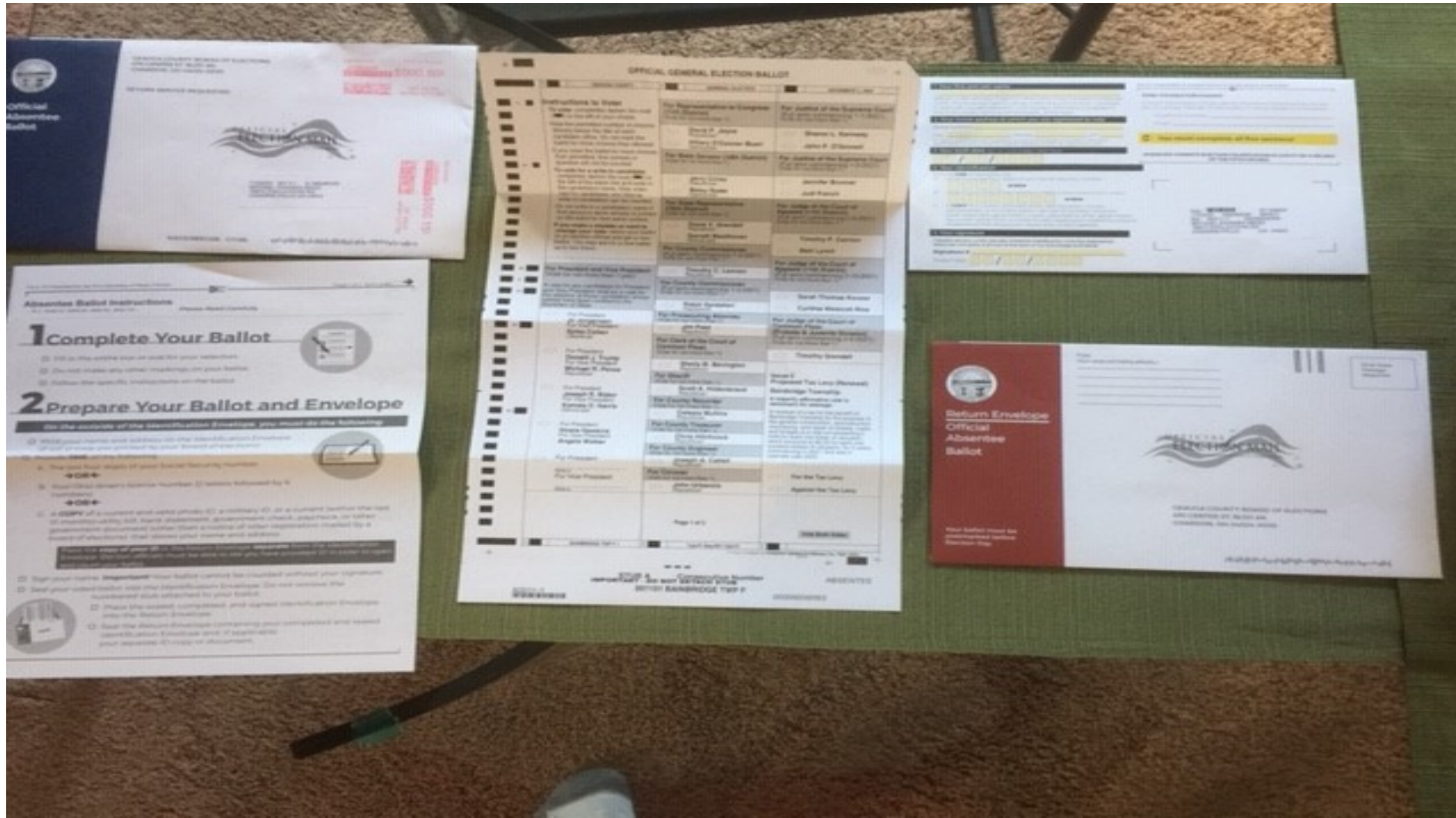


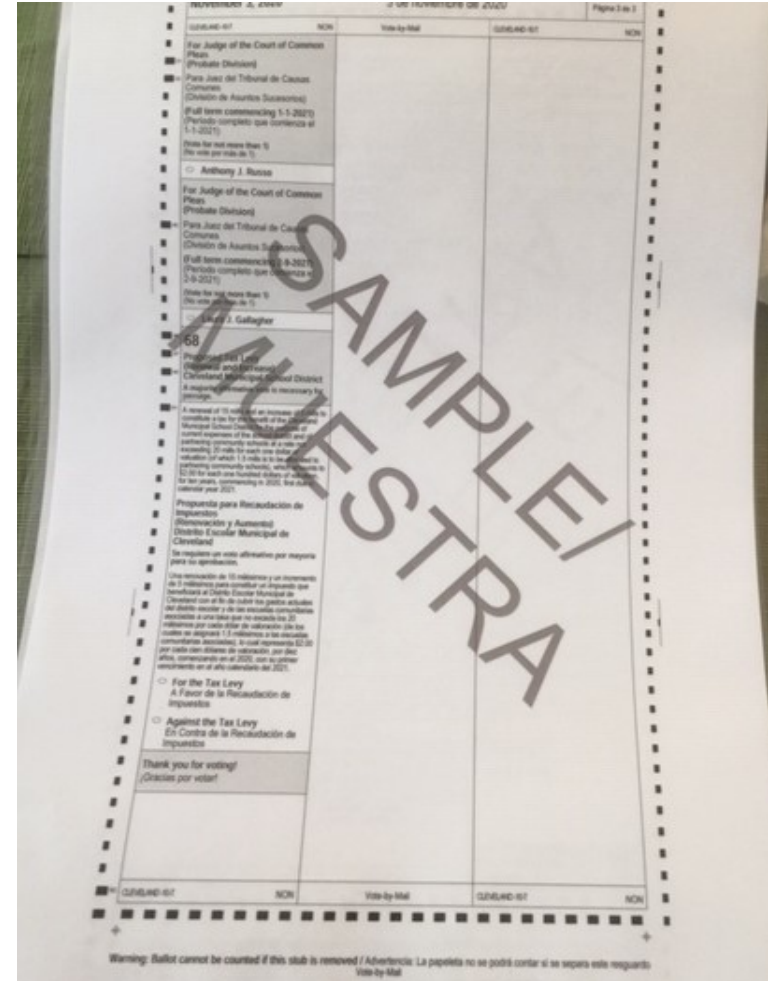
How to Submit Your Absentee Ballot
to Make Sure Your Vote is Counted

What you receive in the mail



The Ballot

- Fill out your ballot carefully.
- Use a black or blue pen and fill in the ovals completely.
- You do not need to vote for all the candidates. You can leave some blank.
- When you do vote for a candidate, vote for only one.
- The ballot had two columns and may be two sided so review the ballot carefully.



Do NOT tear off the bottom of the ballot

- Place your ballot in the inner ID envelope and complete all highlighted sections.
- **** By sure to write your ID number and date of birth,
- **** Sign on the outside of the ID envelope with today's date.
- Add your phone and email on the back flap of the envelope so you can be reached if needed.
- Place the ID envelope into the outer return mailing envelope.
- Put only one ballot in each envelope! If you put multiple ballots in the same envelope, they will not be counted.

If you make a mistake

- If you make a mistake while filling out your ballot (and you still have your ballot in-hand), you can call the Board of Elections at 216-443-8683 and request a new ballot.
- It can take a long time to get a replacement ballot so fill it out carefully.
- If you still have your ballot, you can also go to the Board of Elections at 30th and Euclid to vote early. It is open weekdays and some weekends until the day before the election.

Returning Your Ballot

Option 1: Take Your Ballot to the Board of Elections

- . Only you or a family member may hand-deliver your ballot to the BOE.
- . During business hours, people designated by the BOE will be positioned outside the BOE to take your ballot envelope. You do not need to go inside the building.
- . After hours, you can drive into the BOE parking lot (entrance on E.30) and drop your envelope in the drop box.

Returning Your Ballot

Option 1: Take Your Ballot to the BOE

- You can take your ballot to the BOE up until 7:30 on Election Day, Nov. 3. If you need a ride to the BOE, call 216-883-5036.(Vessels Vote) or 216-801-1101 or 216-294-4261 (Voter Drive in the City of Cleveland)

Returning Your Ballot

- Option 2: Mail your Ballot back to the BOE
 - It is your responsibility to make sure the ballot has enough postage - a postage information slip will be included with the ballot. Timing is important - Ballots must be postmarked by November 2nd.
 - DO NOT WAIT TO MAIL YOUR BALLOT.
 - DO NOT TAKE YOUR BALLOT TO YOUR LOCAL POLLING LOCATION ON ELECTION DAY

Track your ballot to make sure it was counted

- Go to 443Vote.com.
- Click on “Track My Ballot”
- Enter your last name and date of birth. Click SEARCH.
- Your name will appear. Click on your name.
- You will then need to select an election date. Select 11/3/20 Presidential General Election.
